### Local Business Donates Equipment to DUI Crash Reduction Initiative

**August 17, 2004 - Pottsville, PA** – Driving Technology Systems, Inc. (DTS) of Pottsville, PA announced today the donation of equipment and services to the Schuylkill Regional DUI Crash Reduction Initiative. DTS is donating the use of 2 Preliminary Breath Test Machines (PBT), service on over 30 PBTs and service on evidentiary test machines used in prosecution DUI cases.

The Schuylkill Regional DUI Crash Reduction Initiative combines both the Northern and Southern DUI checkpoint initiatives with the Pennsylvania State Police Troop L based out of Reading, PA. Sergeant Chris Blugis of Troop L and Tom R. Ryan, Coordinator of the North Central Highway Safety Network were on hand to receive the donation.

Along with the donation of equipment and services, Driving Technology Systems will train selected members of the initiative to receive training on the use of the equipment that is being donated. This will help to facilitate the proper use of the equipment and help with the rollout of the program.

The donation of services by DTS includes monthly tests of the initiative’s evidentiary test machines and yearly calibrations which are required by Pennsylvania State Law. Maintenance for the PBT’s being donated by DTS, as well as the over 30 PBT’s already in use, will be provided at no cost to the initiative on an as needed basis.

Rollout of the newly donated equipment, maintenance and training will begin immediately, according to Sgt. Chris Blugis. “This donation will help our officers while they are out on the road, immensely” stated Blugis.

“After learning of the implementation of a local DUI initiative, we feel that Driving Technology Systems is in position to contribute to their efforts with our products and services. We asked the Schuylkill Regional DUI Crash Reduction Initiative coordinators how we could help.
